About the project:

Ministry of Stories, in partnership with Modern Fables, is transforming our workshop space in Hoxton in Hackney into a professional standard escape room for the summer holidays. Co-created with a group of 11-15 year olds, the 45 minute long experience will take players on a puzzle solving adventure to another world, unfolding a compelling story as they go.We will be inviting local children and their families to come and play.

We're recruiting a freelance **Operations Manager** to facilitate the smooth running of the escape room and ensure that all participants have an enjoyable and safe experience.

About the role:

The Operations Manager will:

- Prepare the space each morning and perform fire and safety checks
- Welcome and support any MoS volunteers
- Set/reset the escape room between sessions
- Give a warm welcome to players (with potential for this to be done in role as a character from the fictional world)
- Operate the game from the control room, providing clues to participants when needed.
- Debrief participants at the end of their session
- In the event of a fire alarm, ensure that participants are safely evacuated from the building

- Troubleshoot technical issues with the puzzles or props where possible
- Communicate with MoS staff when maintenance is required in the rooms or to props and puzzles
- Handle all enquiries relating to bookings and questions about visits to the escape room
- Send booking reminders to participants via email/SMS

About You:

You will:

- Be familiar with good practice relating to health and safety and fire safety
- Be organised and confident operating the escape room game
- Have the technical and practical skills to troubleshoot problems with the puzzles or props
- Offer a warm welcome and great customer service to participants
- Have experience in escape rooms, stage management and/or a relevant customer service role

Desirable:

- Experience working with children, young people and families
- A current first aid qualification

Contract terms:

The contract runs for 6 weeks from **Tuesday 26th July - Saturday 3rd September**. 40 hrs per week, Tuesday - Saturday.

NB:We will consider splitting the contract between two people. If you would like to be considered for a job share, please indicate your preference and availability (preferably in week-long blocks) when applying.

Successful applicants will need to undergo an enhanced DBS check and receive safeguarding training

Fees:

The total contract fee is $\pounds 2,700$ (or $\pounds 450$ per week), inclusive of VAT if applicable. We do not pay travel expenses.

- a short expression of interest (no more than one side of A4) that outlines why you are interested in the role, and the skills and experience you bring
- An indication of your preference and availability if you would like to be considered for a job share
- a CV or professional biography
- a completed <u>diversity monitoring form</u>

Shortlisted candidates will then be invited to interview on Tuesday 24th May at Ministry of Stories (option for online interview if required, but not preferred).
