About Ministry of Stories

Ministry of Stories is a Hackney-based children's charity that champions the writer in every child. We believe in young people's ideas and imagination, and the power of their voices to make change in the world. We make writing exciting, even for the most reluctant writers.

All of our programmes are led by experienced professional writereducators, who work with children to create imaginative, purposeful writing that results in professional outcomes - from stunning published anthologies and professionally designed newspapers, to exciting performances, audio or film work.

About the Hackney Writing Partnership

We are seeking school partners for a three-year programme of subject leadership support, teacher CPD, writer-led projects for pupils and beautifully produced final outcomes. We will work with a consortium of up to ten Hackney Primary Schools, starting in September 2025.

Over the course of the three years we will equip schools with the Ministry of Stories methodology: first sharing our existing programmes, then creating new programmes together, then finally mentoring and supporting schools to embed our approaches into their teaching practice and curriculum

We have secured a significant grant from the Mercers' Company to support the majority of the costs, meaning schools are only asked to make a contribution of £1,800 per year, equal to just 15% of the total cost of the programme.
