## YOUNG PEOPLE

**97%** said they felt safe at the Ministry of Stories

**74%** felt more confident after taking part

**70%** said their writing had improved

## PARENTS

**90%** felt their child's confidence had increased as a result of taking part

**90%** said their child's writing had improved

**72%** reported that Ministry of Stories had a positive impact on their child's school work

## TEACHERS

**96%** reported their students' confidence had increased

**88%** said their students' writing had improved

**83%** reported a positive impact on their own teaching practice

**179** community writing workshops delivered after school and on Saturdays

**31** primary and secondary programmes delivered
