Ministry of Stories champions the writer in every child.

Co-founded by author Nick Hornby in 2010, we help young people discover their confidence, imagination and potential through the power of their writing. We develop self-respect and communication skills through writing programmes and mentoring for children in our community, working in schools, and at our dedicated writing centre in Hackney. We empower young people to write brighter futures for themselves through the power of their ideas, creativity and imagination.

You'll find us hidden behind our fantastical shop <u>Hoxton Street Monster Supplies</u>, with all proceeds going back to support our work with young people.

Opportunity to lead the Board of Trustees

Ministry of Stories is looking for a new Chair of Trustees. We are seeking a leader who shares our vision of inspiring and supporting young people's ideas, imagination and voice through their creativity and writing. You will have the skills, time, passion and influence to be an important part of our pioneering organisation, helping us to grow and develop, and keeping young people and creativity at our heart.

About the role:

Our Chair of Trustees will:

- Provide leadership to the Board of Trustees, enabling them to provide effective strategic direction and fulfil their governance responsibilities.
- Hold the Board and Senior Management Team to account for the charity's mission, ensuring that each trustee fulfils their responsibilities and is engaged with the charity's work.
- Work closely with the Director to ensure that the Board functions as a unit
- Supporting trustee recruitment to maintain the right mix of skills, expertise and diversity to best support the organisation.
- Platform and profile Ministry of Stories externally, and represent the organisation at Ministry of Stories events, key networking events and relevant meetings with funders and supporters.
- Build and broker relationships with cultural, education, youth, community organisations and other potential partners in close collaboration with the Director, and in furtherance of the charities aims
- Unlock relationships with funders, corporate partners and/or high value individual donors
- Provide line management to the Director

About You:

You will have:

- A strong commitment to the principles underlying the work of the Ministry of Stories: belief in the power of children's creativity and imagination and in inclusiveness
- Experience of operating at a senior strategic level in the arts sector or other relevant field (eg education and learning, youth, creative industries etc)
- The ability to act as an effective ambassador for Ministry of Stories across a variety of networks and contexts
- Keen understanding of fundraising and financial management
- Understanding and experience of charity governance and the chairing role

- Pragmatism, persistence, imagination and optimism
- Experience of supporting organisational growth, ideally including a capital move
- Skills to draw out range of opinions and ideas from diverse perspectives, and chair meetings effectively, bringing about clear actions and conclusions
- The ability to bring appropriate balance of challenge and support
- A good awareness of current and future opportunities regionally and nationally, including in the arts, culture, youth and/or education and learning
- An understanding and commitment to Diversity and Inclusion

Appointment terms:

Trustees serve an initial three-year term and are then eligible for re-appointment for a second term. Chair and vice-chair/s are eligible for a third-term.

All trustee posts are voluntary. Reasonable expenses will be reimbursed.

Governance

The Ministry of Stories is a registered charity (no1138553), governed by a Board of 8-12 trustees. Its trading activity is delivered by a separate trading company, Hoxton Street Monster Supplies, which is run under licence from Ministry of Stories and is governed by a separate Board of Directors. All profits from the trading company are returned to Ministry of Stories. The Board delegates responsibility to designated sub-committees (currently Finance and Fundraising, and Business and Programme) which advise the full board. Sub committees may include staff, board members and expert advisors. All Trustees run the charity in accordance with its governing document.
